What types of projects can get funded?

From cultural cooking sessions, parent and family support groups, local sport clubs, to festive celebrations, we want to support a diverse range of local groups and project ideas. If it's good for the community then we will consider funding it.

- The project must be free for people to participate in.
- The people who benefit must live in Islington.
- You must demonstrate how the project could support or be of benefit to the wider community.

Who can apply?

Individuals & Groups

Groups of three or more individual residents can apply, however, residents who apply should seek support from an established voluntary or community sector organisation who will hold the grant on your behalf – we can help with this.

Local community groups

Small local grass-roots community groups such as tenants and residents associations, parent-teacher associations, mutual aid groups and friends of parks groups can apply but must have an income of less than £50,000.
